

COOKIE NOTICE

When you visit Stalatube's websites, subsites, or use our service, we may collect information through cookies on how you use our service. Cookies are used by most websites, including ours. A cookie is a small piece of data (text file) that a website – when visited by a user – asks your browser to store on your device in order to remember information about you, such as your language preference or login information in order to improve your user experience. Those cookies are set by us and called first-party cookies. We also use third-party cookies, which are cookies from a domain different than the domain of the website you are visiting for our advertising and marketing efforts. We use the term "cookies" in this notice to refer to all files that collect information in this way. This Notice applies to all websites of Stalatube Ltd, unless a specific website states otherwise.

COOKIES USED, THEIR PURPOSES, DURATION, AND HOW TO MANAGE THE COOKIES

Cookies alone cannot be used to identify you, but they may be linked directly or indirectly to you when combined with other information. In these cases, cookies are treated as personal data in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

Stalatube uses cookies to:

- enable site functionality and ensure the security of our websites. The websites use cookies that support site functionality, e.g., to help you access secure areas such as the Stalatube Extranet service. Where permitted by applicable law, Stalatube may set these types of cookies without requesting your consent.
- compile reports and statistical information about the use of our websites and to measure the effectiveness of advertising. Depending on your cookie settings, some of this information can also be shared with third-party analytics providers, e.g., Google Analytics.
- allow you to set personal preferences.
- provide you with relevant content and information (e.g., targeted adverts).

Cookies can either be session cookies (they remain only until you close your browser) or persistent (they remain on your computer or device until you delete them). Session cookies are usually used to remember relevant settings of your browsing session. Persistent cookies may typically be used for targeted advertising and gaining insight on how you use our website. We use both session and persistent cookies.

Persistent cookies are stored on your hard drive in between browser sessions until you delete them or they reach their expiry date. We will not store cookie information from persistent cookies for longer than a maximum of two years.

STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you that amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not work.

PREFERENCE COOKIES

These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies, then some or all of these services may not function properly.

STATISTICAL COOKIES

These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our site and will not be able to monitor its performance.

MARKETING COOKIES

These cookies may be set through our site by our advertising partners. They may be used by those companies to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other sites. They do not store directly personal information but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

SOCIAL MEDIA COOKIES

These cookies are set by a range of social media services that we have added to the site to enable you to share our content with your friends and networks. They are capable of tracking your browser across other sites and building up a profile of your interests. This may impact the content and messages you see on other websites you visit. If you do not allow these cookies you may not be able to use or see these.

MANAGING AND DECLINING COOKIES

In our cookie settings, you may manage your cookie settings and specify which cookies you allow. Declining cookies means that only the cookies and similar technologies that are strictly necessary for the provision of our website will be stored. You may change your cookie preferences, for example, withdraw your consent, at any time by clicking our cookie settings. You may also block all the cookies by changing the setting in your browser to "disable cookies" (please see the instructions in your browser's user guide). The use of some areas of our websites may, however, be restricted or they may not function properly if you block or do not consent to the use of cookies.

YOUR RIGHTS AS A DATA SUBJECT

In addition to other legal rights you may have, you may have the following rights in respect of any personal data we collect about you:

- To ask that Stalatube provide you a copy of any identifiable personal data processed by Stalatube.
- To ask that Stalatube corrects any incorrect or deficient identifiable personal data Stalatube holds concerning you.
- To ask that Stalatube erase any such identifiable personal data concerning you that Stalatube does not have a legal basis to hold.
- To ask that Stalatube similarly restricts the processing of the data e.g. while you await Stalatube's response to another lawful request by you that Stalatube stop processing data concerning you.
- To object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to Stalatube having a sufficient legitimate interest to collect some specific identifiable personal data concerning you.
- To withdraw your consent given to Stalatube at any time.
